



Intern for Anti-Discrimination Project THROUGH DIFFERENT EYES

Are you interested in applying your knowledge in an artistic, socially-critical environment? Are you in need for an interesting project for your term paper or thesis? Do you enjoy working in an interdisciplinary team? Then you might be just the right person for our internship position.

THROUGH DIFFERENT EYES is a unique diversity project. The idea is that the individual participant, with the help of make-up artists and actors, takes on a different skin color or gender for one day. THROUGH DIFFERENT EYES was created in 2011 by actor Morten Nielsen. It started as an ambitious art project in Denmark and then also developed on an international platform, with partners such as the Curitiba Festival in Brazil and the culture house Katuaq in Greenland. Recently the project has increasingly been integrated in diversity trainings in other sectors. One example is the collaboration with Denmark's biggest trade union 3F. Due to the very positive responses to that development we are now seeking to further the work on transforming THROUGH DIFFERENT EYES from an art project to a sustainable social business project - and this is where you come into the picture.

Your tasks:

- active participation in adapting THROUGH DIFFERENT EYES to contemporary social currents and developments
- contribution to the extension of an international network of collaboration partners
- development of sales strategies in an interdisciplinary team with a student from a marketing background
- proactive communication tasks (website, social media, relevant magazines etc.)

You offer:

- desire for working with social change, equality, anti-racism, anti-discrimination
- documented communication experience, both in English and Danish
- experience with working in an NGO (desirable but not obligatory)
- interested in following the project from an analytical, critical perspective
- skilled in dealing with creative processes
- competent in working both independently and in team work
